### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

What is the cost of the service?

- The **PrintingOnline and delivery** service costs **59€ + 21% VAT = 71.39€**
- Collect it on-site at the Registration Desk.


What is the production quality of the poster produced?

- The poster is available with 4 colour printing on 200g/m<sup>2</sup> photographic paper.
- Poster size 90 x 130 cm portrait (vertical).

When is the deadline?

- The deadline for submitting a poster is **5th November 2015 at 23:59 (GMT+1)**.

A common mistake in posters we receive is incorrect dimensions. This can cause distortion to the final format for printing.
